



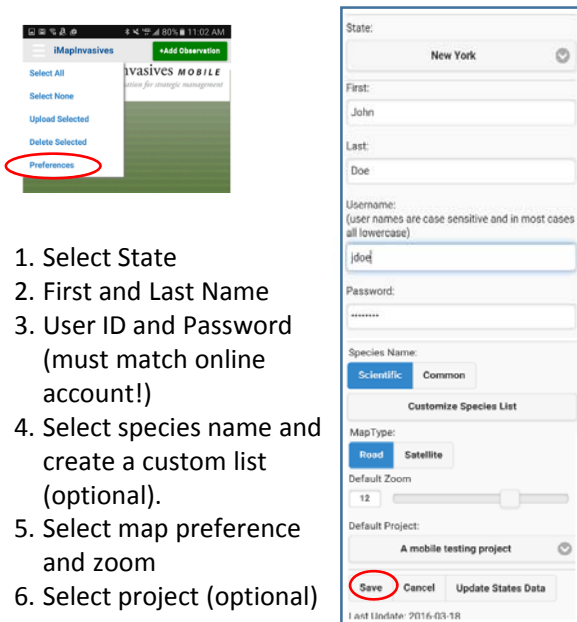
iMapinvasives Mobile App for Android or Apple

Report invasive species locations using your tablet or smartphone

- First you will need to request an iMapInvasives_login online at:
www.NYiMapinvasives.org
- Download the app from Google Play or iTunes (search for “imapinvasives”)

Preferences

“Preferences” are your customized user settings. You will need to fill in your iMapInvasives account information to upload reports to the database.



1. Select State
2. First and Last Name
3. User ID and Password (must match online account!)
4. Select species name and create a custom list (optional).
5. Select map preference and zoom
6. Select project (optional)

Make sure to save changes!

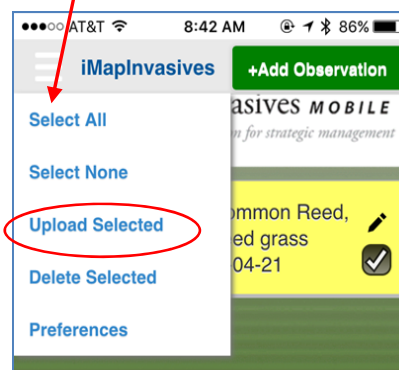
