The Pesticide Reporting Law (PRL)

The PRL requires submission of annual reports by February 1 of each year, detailing pesticide activities for the prior calendar year. Certified Commercial Applicators, Technicians, Aquatic Anti-Fouling Paint Applicators and Commercial Permittees are required to submit the annual reports.




